

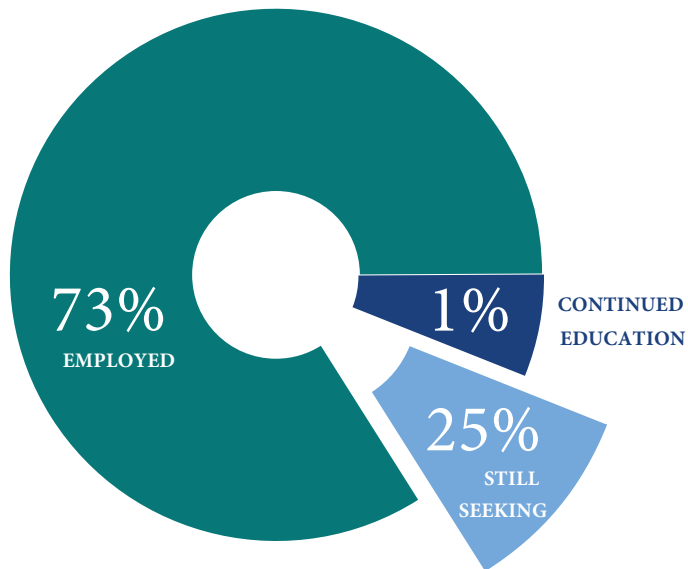
# CAREER OUTCOMES FOR 2018 SPS GRADUATES

## EMPLOYED-AT-GRADUATION

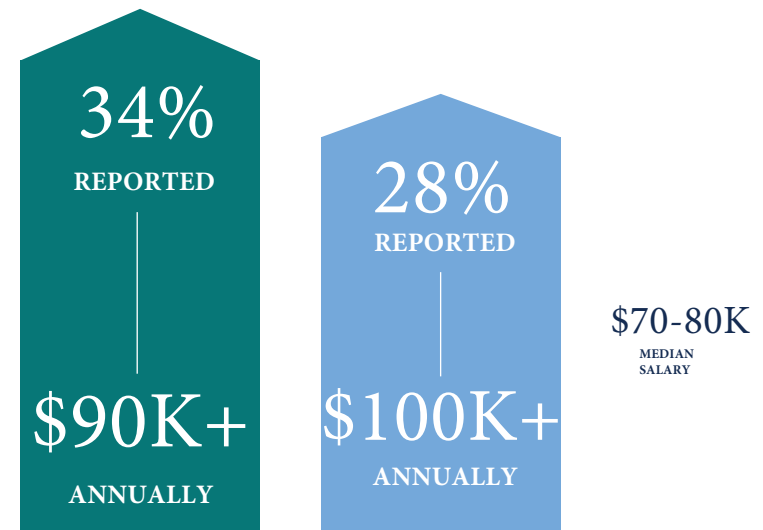
FISCAL YEAR 2018 ASSESSMENT PERIOD: JULY 1, 2017 — JUNE 30, 2018
