
Register Full Time

- Courses are held on-campus
- Online classes:

 You can count only ONE online class toward your minimum number of credits required for your full-time enrollment.

F-1 and J-1 Visa Regulations

- 1. Make normal academic progress toward degree
- 2. Full-time course load every semester





On-Campus Employment

- 1. Work done for and paid by a Columbia office or department
- 2. Immediately eligible
- 3. Part-time: Up to 20 hours per week during school year
- 4. Full-time: Vacation periods during program of study





F-1 CPT - Curricular Practical Training



Fulfills a requirement or elective towards your degree completion



During degree

F-1 OPT - Optional Practical Training





Limited to 12 months per degree level





During and/or after degree

CPT or OPT

You will be eligible for CPT or OPT after two consecutive full-time semesters in the U.S. in F-1 status

- Some transfer students may be immediately eligible
- The application process is online
- Not all programs have CPT as part of the curriculum
